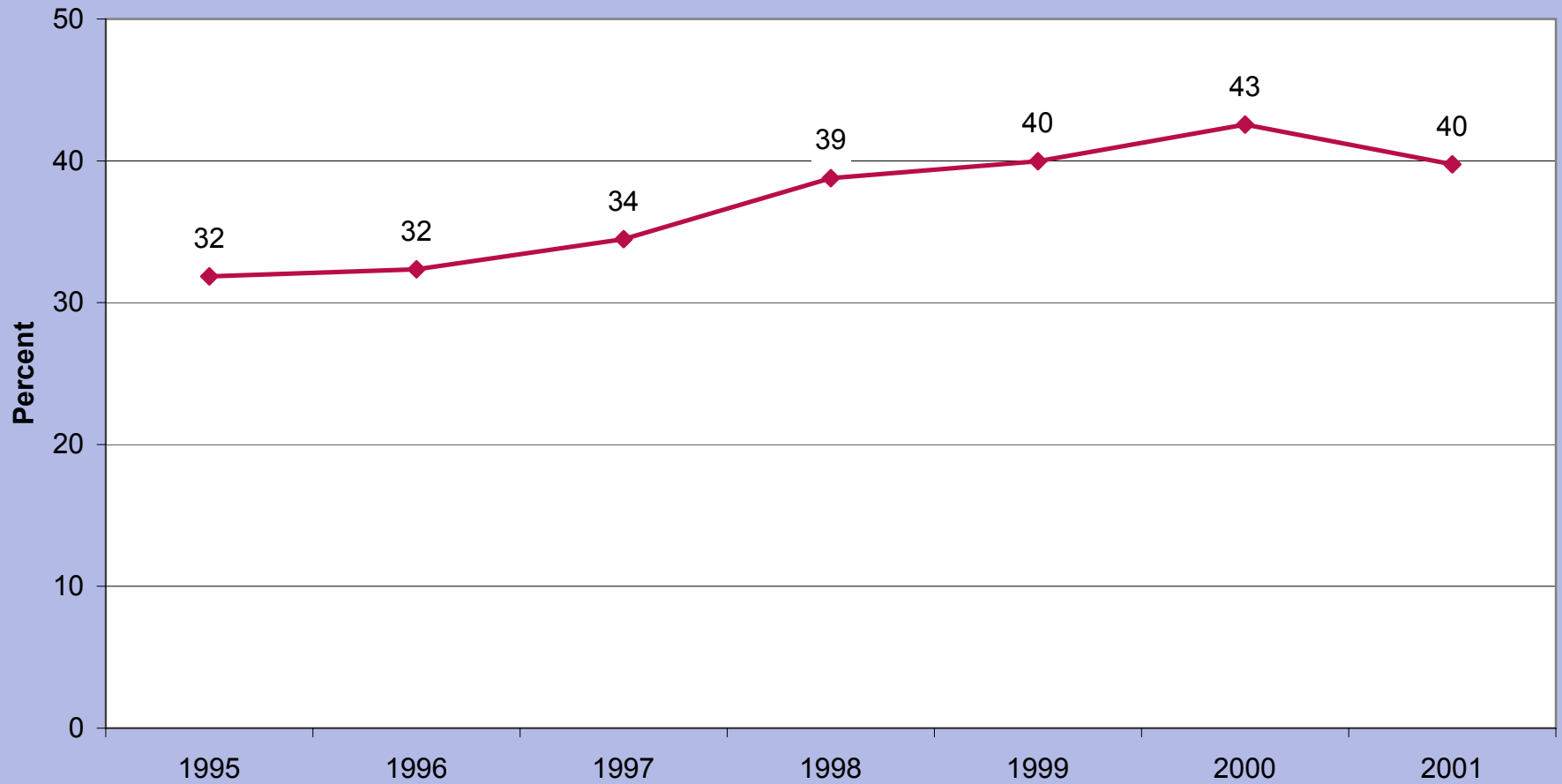

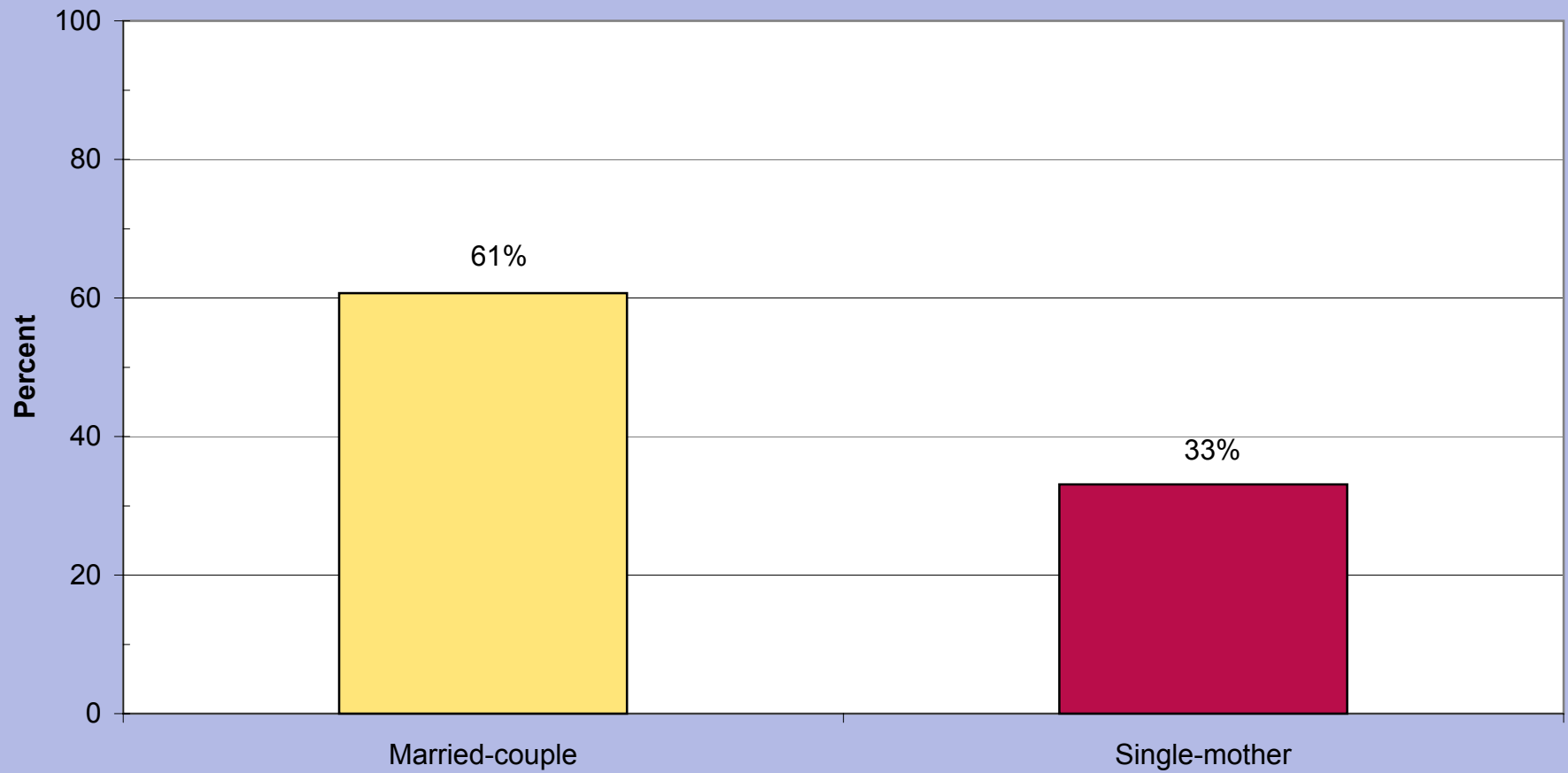
Among Poor Children, Percentage in Working Poor Families, 1995-2001

Among Poor Children, Percentage in Working Poor Families, by Family Structure, 2001

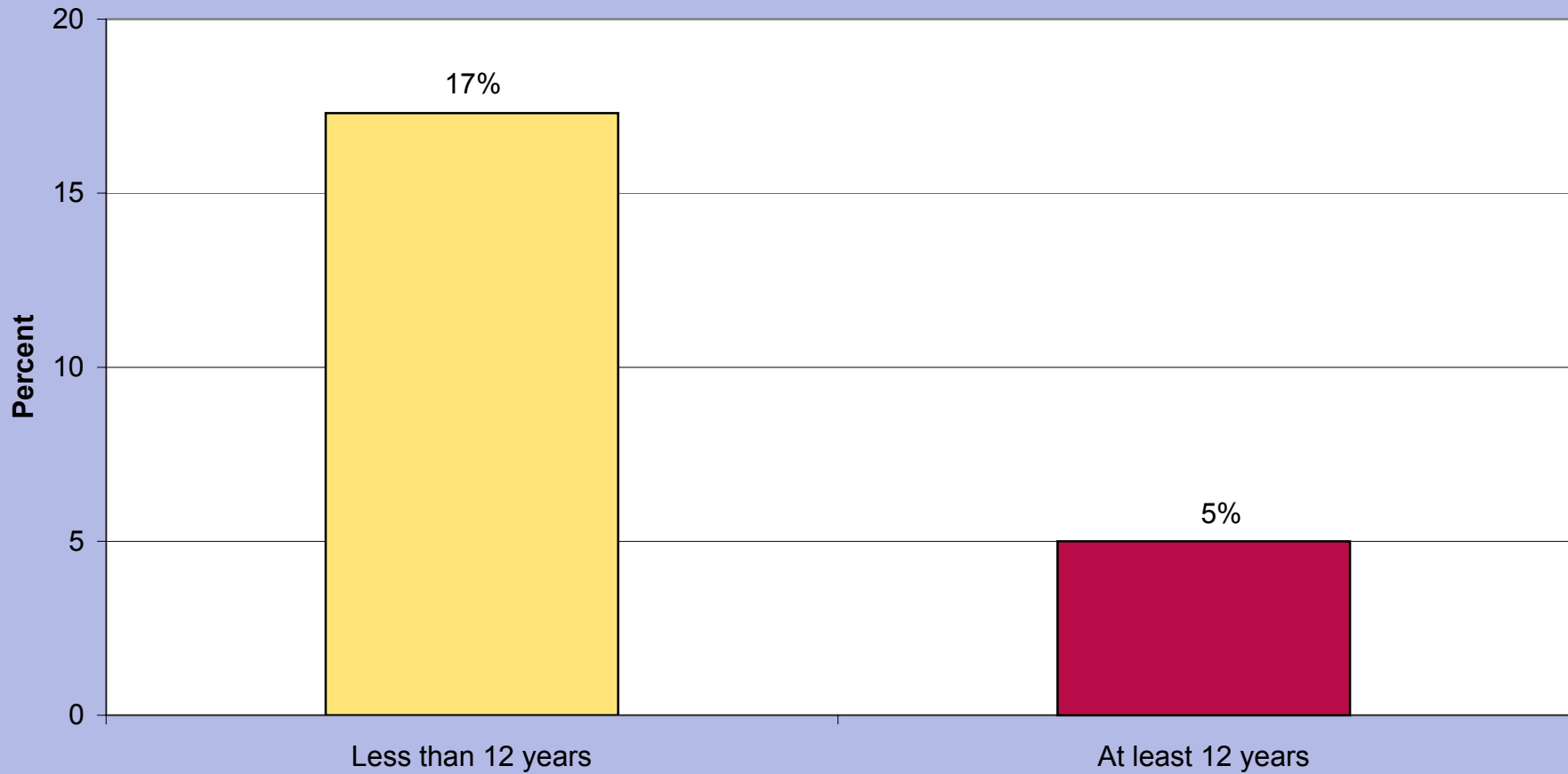
